Message from the Section 1515 Chair by Enrique Bekerman

At this writing, we've held our first two meetings of section 1515.

Our October meeting was facilitated by Fred Gilliam CEO of E3, LLC. Fred explained the importance of consensus building as a decision making tool. He then facilitated a fun "survival" team exercise designed to demonstrate the concept. Each team arrived at individual answers and then reached a consensus set of answers. Consensus usually results in better decisions, but even more important, by being involved in the decision making process each team member has "bought-into" the final decision. For true consensus to occur each member of the team must have an equal voice.

Heather Oppenheimer, Senior Partner, Oppenheimer Partners, LLC presented an introduction to CMMI and SCAMPI at our November dinner meeting. The model which originated in software development has now been adopted in a large variety of industries. The CMMI business model is quite compatible with methodologies such as Six Sigma, ISO-9000, Lean and Agile Manufacturing. Unlike ISO-9000, the end result of CMMI is not a certificate, but a rating against a 1-5 scale which measures the capability and maturity of the organization. Many customers today are starting to specify a minimum maturity level from suppliers, so it is clear that we will be hearing more about this model in the future. Heather is conducting a three day introductory course on the subject in January.

Our January 17, 2008 meeting will feature Phil Centonze, Founding Partner of Pos-Impact, LLC. Phil has delivered several ex-

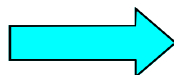
